ADVISING AND ACADEMIC COACHING

Faculty, advisors, and mentors help Cabrini students every step of the way—as they transition from high school, through their first year of college, and on to graduation.

- First-year students enroll in a weekly **Success Seminar** that guides them through the process of self-discovery, helps them develop skills necessary to be successful and thrive in college, and fosters resiliency. Seminar instructors serve as a student's dedicated academic advisor, helping them to select courses and majors and to understand degree requirements. They also connect students with campus resources until they formally declare a major and begin working with a faculty advisor within their major department.
- Professional Advisors** serve as personal success coaches when students want extra support and guidance to ensure academic success.
- Students have the opportunity to belong to Navigate, Cav Cares or other **mentoring programs**, in addition to **Learning Communities** where students are partnered with supportive faculty, staff, and peers to help with their personal transition to the Cabrini community.

- ✓ Cabrini's **Center for Career and Professional Development** helps students select a major that is the right fit, receive academic credit for internships, explore job opportunities, and prepare for graduate/professional school admission.
